You are the spider in the web that manages the internal and external stakeholders. During the origination phase you will be consulting in the preparation, permitting phase for a thorough and optimal first design of the project.

Main tasks and responsibilities

The following are some of the key responsibilities that will be part of your role:

- Project Planning Construction: Create a plan that outlines the scope, timeline, budget, and resources required for the construction of the project.
- Project Management Construction: Manage the project team, monitor progress, and track project deliverables against the project plan.

- Risk Management: Identify, assess, and mitigate project risks to ensure that the project stays on track and within budget.
- Communication: Communication is an essential part of the role. You must communicate regularly with stakeholders, including clients, team members, and senior management. If necessary, you travel to our partners (within the Netherlands) to consult with them.
- Resource Allocation: Allocate resources efficiently to ensure that the construction of the project is completed on time and within budget.
- Quality Control Ensure that the project meets the quality standards set by Dispatch & partners.
- Problem Solving: A technical project manager must be able to identify and solve problems quickly and efficiently with assistance of experts & team to keep the construction on track.
- Documentation: Document project progress, issues, and outcomes to ensure that the project is well-documented for future reference.
- Design & Project Optimisation Consulting: During the origination phase you will consult on the preparation, permitting phase for a thorough and optimal first design & H&E management of the project.
